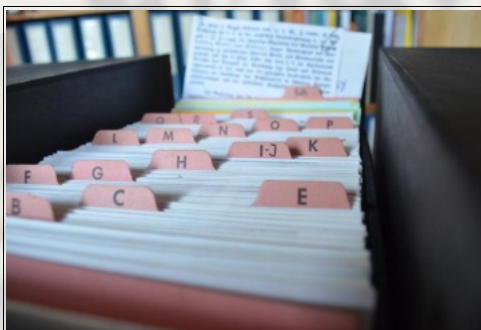
II.
